1 out of every 5 Black men in the U.S. is diagnosed with prostate cancer. These fathers and sons die from the disease at a rate 2.4 times higher than men of all other racial and ethnic groups.

The Prostate Health Education Network (PHEN) and churches nationwide are partnering to host the "5th Annual Father's Day Rally Against Prostate Cancer" - the largest prostate cancer education and awareness effort in Black America.
